**05/24/OS/04 – To consider and approve repairs to Ferrers Avenue boundary fence –** With the weather now improving repairs should be considered. A local contract is to be approached to quote for repairs as per his recommendation. It was also thought that we should consider the use of signage to warn perpetrators.
